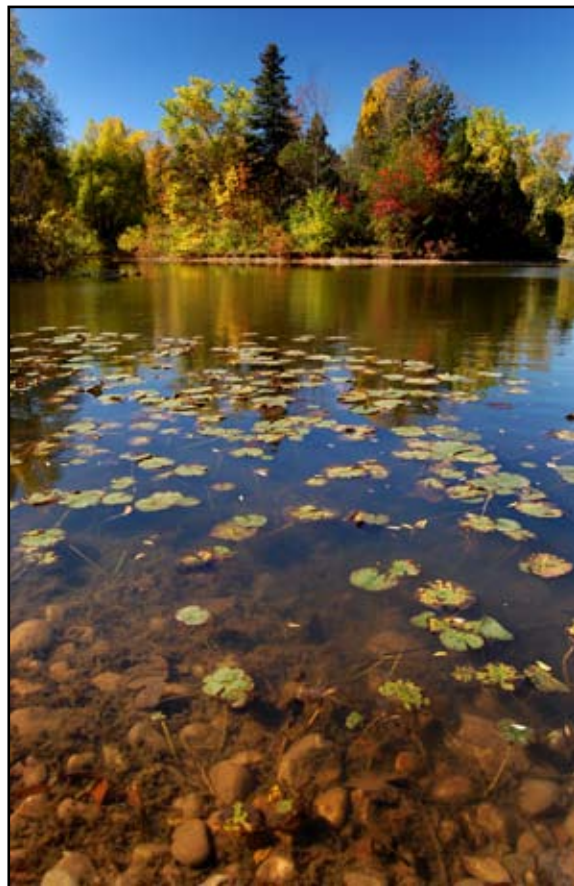

RECREATION

Schlitz Audubon Nature Center's 5 miles of trails take visitors through 185 acres of unspoiled natural beauty just 15 minutes north of downtown Milwaukee on the shore of Lake Michigan. Visit the Center year-round to hike, jog, stroll along the beach, or find a quiet haven to commune with nature. In chilly weather, the landscape becomes a perfect winter wonderland for snowshoeing and cross-country skiing.



EDUCATION

Schlitz Audubon Nature Center (SANC) provides nature education programs for the pre-school level up to adults of any age. Each year, more than 35,000 children and 145,000 visitors come to SANC to experience the magic of nature. Our spacious outdoor classroom, talented environmental educators, and diversity of program topics make for unforgettable experiences.

School Programs

Schlitz Audubon Nature Center opens young eyes to the lessons, joys, and mysteries of nature. The Center's fully licensed Nature Preschool, established in 2003, was the first of its kind in Wisconsin. The preschool's mission is to provide a high-quality early childhood environment that meets preschoolers' developmental needs while inspiring them to love nature.

The Center's elementary, middle school, and secondary environmental classes complement students' school science curricula. Students experience active, hands-on learning in our outdoor classroom. Our licensed educators also take our interactive natural science programs to schools in southeast Wisconsin and northern Illinois.

Adult Programs

Our adult programs feature off-site day and overnight trips plus on-site adventures at the Center. We help nature lovers of all ages expand their understanding and appreciation of the natural world.

Summer Camp

SANC offers a variety of week-long, nature-based science camps for ages 3 – 14. We are licensed by the State of Wisconsin. Children may attend anywhere from one to eight weeks and will enjoy hiking the trails, exploring life in the ponds, and meeting some of our resident animals such as Maria the Rosy Boa Constrictor. Our camps are taught by trained SANC educational staff.

Live Raptor Programs

Our Sky Hunters Birds of Prey Raptor Program is the most comprehensive of its kind within a 350 mile radius of the Center. We are certified by the USDA; and carry permits from US Fish & Wildlife and Wisconsin DNR; as well as holding Endangered Species and Bald and Golden Eagle permits. All of our raptors have been injured and are non-releasable to the wild, providing a unique opportunity to engage, inspire, and educate the public. Our state-of-the-art Raptor Flight and Care Facility is currently home to over a dozen birds of prey: eagles, owls, hawks, falcons, and a vulture.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Our volunteers provide much-needed support for our facility, grounds, programs, and classes. Volunteer positions include hosts, hostesses, Nature Preschool aides, green building tour guides, nature photographers, land stewards, raptor assistants, clerical workers, and carpenters. Environmental education and land stewardship have been at the heart of our mission for more than 37 years. Our Gold LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) award-winning green building opened in 2003.
