# Nature Preschool

## SCHEDULE

We offer part-day classes for three to five-year-olds. Children must be three by September 1 of the year they enroll and must be toilet trained. Our school year begins September 8, 2009 and ends May 28, 2010. We are a 9-month program and require a commitment to the entire school year.

## CLASS OFFERINGS

Classes are composed of mixed age groups of three to five-year-olds unless otherwise noted.

### Two Days per Week Options

#### **Tuesday/Thursday mornings**

8:45am to 11:30am

or

9:00am to 11:45am

#### **Monday/Wednesday afternoon**

12:30pm to 3:15pm

#### **Tuesday/Thursday afternoons**

12:30pm to 3:15pm

### Three Days per Week Options

#### **Monday/Wednesday/Friday mornings**

8:45am to 11:30am

or

9:00am to 11:45am

---

### Four Days per Week Option

(K4 option - must be 4 by September 1)

#### **Monday through Thursday afternoons**

12:45pm to 3:30 pm

Each class has a maximum adult/child ratio of 8:1 with at least two teachers per class.



## TUITION

Tuition rates for the 2009-2010 school year are as follows;

Two day a week program	\$2100.00*
Three day a week program	\$2920.00*
Four day a week program	\$3590.00*

*\*Tuition includes a new or renewed family membership to SANC. For families enrolling more than one child, \$50 is subtracted from the second child's tuition.*

## SELECTION PROCEDURES

At the end of the business day on each posted date, applications are pulled in random order. Children are then placed in classes according to the preferred days and time listed on the application. When all classes are full, remaining applications are kept on file throughout the year and used to fill unexpected openings. Every attempt is made to place children in their preferred class. However, we reserve the right to create optimal learning communities by balancing classes according to gender and age.

## NOTIFICATION

Families are notified of their placement mid-February. A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required within 10 days of acceptance. This amount is applied to second semester tuition.
